



Before George went to Kansas to sow the seed of the Gospel he worked in Pinedale with us. We love George and believe he will always be a great asset to the Ministry our Lord has let us run. George has been and I believe will be used greatly by our Lord in the future. George always gives Mary and I a different prospective on things. I am hoping you will be touched and uplifted by his love for Jesus and his down home outlook on things.

Many times I sit and ponder the current status of the World. No, not that the end grows nearer each day, or the fact that bible prophecies are being fulfilled faster now than in all of mankind's history. These are things that are as natural to me as loving my Jesus. What I sit and ponder is this, Mary and I go to the ministry office almost ever night to pray over the prayer requests, the Ministry is associated with 18 prayer groups. Of these 18 groups several deal only with children. If I were one of those theatrical pastors I could rip out your hearts by going into detail over the pain and suffering many of these children are going through. We pray almost nightly over children from less than one year old up that have cancer, heart problems, strange diseases that cannot even be diagnosed. Sometimes it just makes me weep when I read these prayer requests. Have you noticed how our children are having so many more health problems that used to only attack adults? Just take a look at the upswing in Asthma in the children of this country. I have cried out to the lord and asked WHY? The Lord gave me a Scripture in Malachi 2:1-3 ¹*"And now this commandment is for you, O priests. ²"If you do not listen, and if you do not take it to heart to give honor to My name," says the LORD of hosts, "then I will send the curse upon you and I will curse your blessings; and indeed, I have cursed them already, because you are not taking it to heart. ³"Behold, I am going to rebuke your offspring,..."* The word here in the Hebrew for rebuke is to corrupt. God is saying that because the men and women of God have refused to listen and give Him honor. Take a truthful look at the evils that have come to light in the last few years concerning Men and Women of God. The last few years it has come to light that the priests of the Catholic church have not only been molesting, our children but the church covered it up by moving the offender. Our main stream men of God are saying God is doing a new thing and ordaining homosexuals. It goes so far as declaring the Bible hate literature. Did you get that?? If you quote the Bible against Homosexuality you are breaking the laws of man. Who will you follow? If we don't turn back and fall on our faces it will be too late - if it isn't already!

I leave you with this final thought. Yellowstone National Park is the country's premiere park, it is the gemstone of our park system so to speak. This Months Bible Moment

“No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man ...” (1 Corinthians 10:13). Did you ever think why me when temptation comes your way. But Paul tells us the we have never suffered any temptation that is not common to man. We do not rate any special temptations. It took me a long time to understand that temptation itself is not sin. Sin comes in when we act on the temptation. When we let the temptation take control. Then the seed of sin is born. I have heard many a preacher say we have to sin. That it is alright to sin because we are human. All we have to do is repent and all is forgiven and we are again covered by the blood. **WRONG!** 1 John 3:4-6 says ***4Those who sin are opposed to the law of God, for all sin opposes the law of God. 5And you know that Jesus came to take away our sins, for there is no sin in him. 6So if we continue to live in him, we won't sin either. But those who keep on sinning have never known him or understood who he is.*** The point here is we are not to keep sinning but that is another teaching. That was for free. Now back to temptation. Though it is tempting to me to teach on not sinning 😊😊😊

Temptation takes many forms, but don't kid yourself it is something very serious. The forms of temptation are determined by our spiritual maturity. An example from real life. I know this man of God whose whole goal in life is to serve Jesus. He has gone from "it is so hard to be humble when you are perfect in every way to I am not worthy to serve the Lord but He lets me." The Lord has been working on his heart to keep his eyes on Jesus no matter what happens. This was brought home to him when on a recent trip his wife experienced some severe stomach pain. They were on the road and He prayed for her and nothing seemed to help. Finally He took his eyes off her pain and told Jesus that He was his only supply and he had nothing or no one if Jesus was not there for him. He looked up and saw a 20' x 30' billboard that said along the top "THE ONLY SOLUTION IS". In the middle in rainbow letters was "JESUS", and along the bottom was in red letters "**all his promises will come true**". He said "look" to his wife, she saw a rainbow colored billboard with a woman and Spanish lettering. By the way, at the moment that he saw the billboard his wife's pain stopped and she had no more problems the rest of the trip. After the trip the old devil started to work on him to try to get his eyes off Jesus. First problems arose. When this did not work the old scoundrel started to work on his ego. Women were making advances toward him. One stranger came up to him and told him how nice he smelled. His only comment was "one usually smells clean after a shower." One woman came up from nowhere and put her hand on his shoulder and rubbed it. All the red warning lights went off. The Devil was on the prowl. This was confirmed by a dream that his wife had. But you notice that the temptation was of that known to man. **EGO**. But Praise God that He did as we are told in 1 Corinthians 10:13 ***13No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, so that you will be able to endure it.*** God provided the escape, a spiritual nature that kept his eyes on Jesus not the human ego. The form of your temptation will depend on where you stand spiritually. The temptation will be to confuse you and take your eyes off what the Lord wants for you. If you follow the temptation you will fall right into the Devil's plans and he will win. Temptation is something we cannot escape if we are striving to follow the Lord and His will.

If you are living a life without any temptation, then I would venture to guess that you are so far away from where Jesus wants you that you are not a threat to the Devil.

This past week Jay and I went to Denver Colorado to baptize my brother Herb, and to anoint and pray over his grandson Tobi. Tobi has cerebral palsy; he rarely walks and has trouble with his speech. If you met Tobi, you would love him. He has a beautiful smile on his face almost all the time, even though he has a lot that he could complain about. Tobi wants to be an all star wrestler, his mom believes that he already is, considering his strength and determination, and I am inclined to agree with her. The point I want to make is this, Tobi is happy despite his circumstances and the card that life has dealt him. We are asking Jesus to heal Tobi, and millions of people around the world are praying for Tobi's healing. Tobi wants to walk, and he has made some progress towards that, but if you met him you would realize that Tobi is a content and happy little boy. We could all learn so much from this precious child of God. How often do you just stop and count your blessings? I know I had a prayer time after we left my brother's house a few days ago where I just praised and thank the Lord for all the blessings in my life.

Here are some facts that might help you develop an attitude of gratitude in your own life.

1. Did you know that if you own just one Bible, you are abundantly blessed?
One-third of the world does not have access to even one.
2. If you woke up this morning with more health than illness, you are more blessed than the million who will not survive the week.
3. If you have never experienced the danger of battle, the loneliness of imprisonment, the agony of torture or the pangs of starvation, you are ahead of 500 million people around the world.
4. If you attend a church meeting without fear of harassment, arrest or threats of torture and death, you are more blessed than almost three billion people in the world.
5. If you have food in your refrigerator, clothes on your back, a roof over your head and a place to sleep, you are richer than 73% of the world.
6. If you have money in the bank, in your wallet, and spare change in your pocket, you are among the top 8% of the world's wealthy.
7. If your parents are still married and alive, you are rare indeed.
8. If you can read this article, you are more blessed than over two billion people in the world that can't read at all.

Still think that you have nothing to be grateful for? Visit a nursing home, a hospital, or a pediatric cancer center. Spend a day with a beautiful child such as Tobi, and you will gain a different perspective on life. Years ago when I was going through some problems, a good Christian friend told me to make a list of everything in my life I could be grateful for. I made two columns one was titled blessings and the other was titled tribulations,

after about a month of adding things to the columns I noticed that many of the things I had listed in the tribulation column I had transferred to my list of blessings. Today try thanking God for even the tribulations in your life, for they are there to do a work in you. When we suffer physically, we learn endurance. When we suffer emotionally, we learn to be at peace in the shelter of the arms of Jesus. God has a purpose in everything that we go through in life, sometimes our suffering has nothing to do with us, but it will teach someone around us to be grateful and more compassionate. We may question God's purpose, but we must never question His Infinite wisdom. There are things that we will go through in this life that we will never see the reason for until we are in heaven.

When we meet a precious child such as Tobi, we may wonder why God allowed his disability, but we cannot see beyond the veil of this life to know the answer. I know that Joni Eareckson-Tada has been in a wheelchair for over thirty years of her Christian life, unable to move anything below her shoulders. I also know that God has used her mightily in a way that He couldn't have if she had never been paralyzed. I am reading her book Heaven right now and in it she says that she cannot wait to get to heaven, not so much to be able to run and jump but so that she can kneel at the feet of Jesus and thank Him. So whenever you are tempted to second guess God's purpose for a tribulation in your life, try praising Him for it instead, pretty soon you will have a list of blessings that are too numerous to count.



Our final praise of the month is that we got to spend time with our daughter Sharol on the way to our son's wedding. Below are pictures of Mr. and Mrs. Warner. Neil and Corina. It was a very long trip we covered 5000 miles in 8 days. But Mary got to see the ocean for the first time in her life. On the way back

we stopped at Carlsbad Caverns and went 850' underground. A very long trip but a good time. Neil and his wife live in McAllen Texas.



I just thought I would share that with our extended family. May our Lord and Savior bless your lives and may you find a renewed relationship with Jesus. The only thing that really matters in this world.
